**Gisle Løkken**, architect MNAL from NTH in Trondheim, Norway - founding partner and manager of 70°N arkitektur. Through architecture competitions and large scale planning programs, he is continuously taking a critical position in the public debate concerning architecture, urban development and regional planning, both locally and in a broader Scandinavian context - this with an experimental approach to planning, lately in the winning entries; *Mosaïc::Region* in the planning ideas competition Øresundsvisioner 2040, and; *Excentral Park – Edge Dynamics* urban development Nordhavnen, Copenhagen.

Løkken is regularly teaching at Bergen Architecture School - recently as responsible teacher for the master studio; *City as biotope* with Malmö, Sweden as study field - and at NTNU, Trondheim. He is regularly demanded as a lecturer and assessor at architecture schools and architect associations, as well as jury member in competitions and prize committees, nationally and internationally. His work has been exhibited, published and awarded. Løkken was member of the board of the Scientific Committee – Europan8 – 2004-2007, chairman of the board of the Architects' Association of Northern Norway 2005-2008, and he is since 2009 vice president of the Association of Architects in Norway, NAL.

As own practice, Løkken (in addition to work done within 70°N arkitektur as) has done cultural heritage registrations in Arctic and Antarctic – his private cottage has been published widely and has been rewarded with the Architecture price of North Norway – he has received the Norsk Form (Norwegian Form) Award to Young Architects, and has carried out extensive work as teacher and lecturer both in Norway and internationally.
